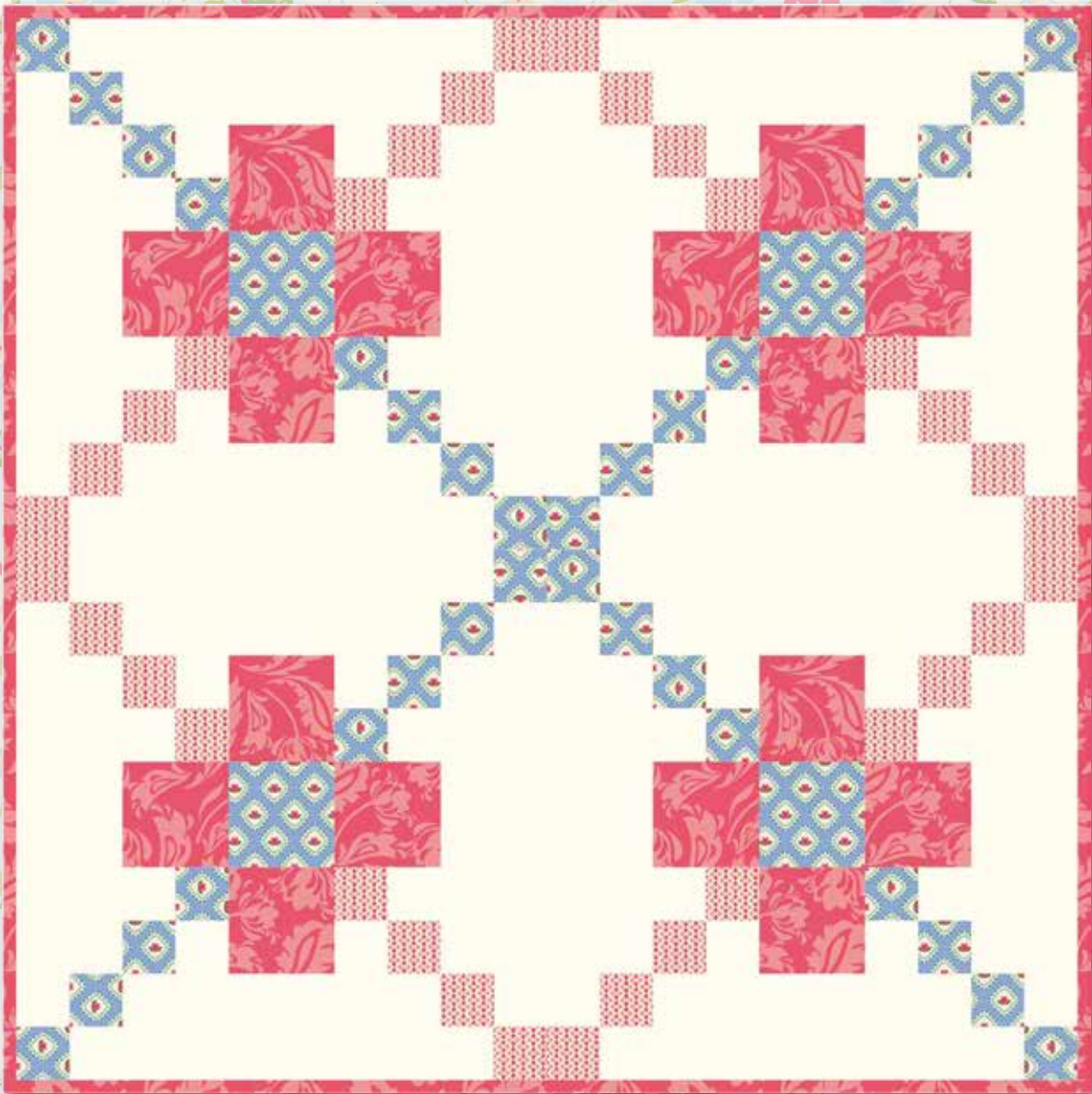


Tulip Chain

Tulip Chain

Finished Quilt Size 40" x 40"

Finished Block Size 20" x 20"

Measurements include 1/4" seam allowance.

Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Please check our website www.rileyblakedesigns.com for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting technique and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

3/8 yard (35 cm) pink damask (C4321 Pink)

3/8 yard (35 cm) blue tulip (C4323 Blue)

1/4 yard (25 cm) pink diamond (C4324 Pink)

3/4 yard (70 cm) vintage white solid (C100-04 Vintage White)

Binding 5/8 yard (60 cm)

Backing 3 1/4 yards (3m)

CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

Please read instructions first before cutting.

Pink Damask

Cut 2 strips 4 1/2" x WOF. Cut the strips into 16 squares 4 1/2" x 4 1/2".

Blue Tulip

Cut 2 strips 2 1/2" x WOF.

Cut 1 strip 4 1/2" x WOF. Cut the strip into 4 squares 4 1/2" x 4 1/2".

Pink Diamond

Cut 2 strips 2 1/2" x WOF.

Vintage White

Cut 4 strips 2 1/2" x WOF.

Cut 2 strips 12 1/2" x WOF. Cut the strip into 16 rectangles 4 1/2" x 12 1/2".

QUILT ASSEMBLY

Refer to quilt photo for placement of fabrics and blocks.

Chain Block

Sew a blue tulip 2 1/2" strip and a vintage white solid 2 1/2" strip together. Press. Repeat with remaining blue tulip strip and a vintage white solid strip. Cut the strips into 2 1/2" segments. Sew the segments together to create 16 Blue Four-Patch Units.

Sew a pink diamond 2 1/2" strip and a vintage white solid 2 1/2" strip together. Press. Repeat with remaining pink diamond

strip and a vintage white solid strip. Cut the strips into 2 1/2" segments. Sew the segments together to create 16 Pink Four-Patch Units.



Blue Four-Patch Unit



Pink Four-Patch Unit

Sew 2 Pink Diamond Four-Patch Units, 2 Blue Tulip Four-Patch Units, 4 pink damask 4 1/2" squares, and 1 blue tulip 4 1/2" square together to create the Center Unit.



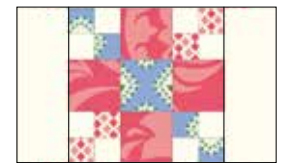
Center Unit

Sew a Pink Diamond Four-Patch Unit and a Blue Tulip Four-Patch Unit to the sides of a vintage white solid 4 1/2" x 12 1/2" rectangle to create Unit A. Repeat to create 8 Unit As.

Sew a vintage white solid 4 1/2" x 12 1/2" rectangle to each side of the Center Unit to create Unit B. Repeat to create 4 Unit Bs.

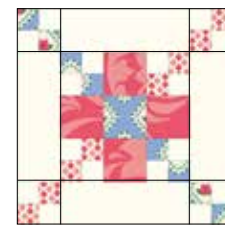


Unit A

Sew a Unit A to the top and bottom of Unit B to create the Chain Block. Repeat to create 4 Chain Blocks.



Chain Block

Quilt Center Assembly

Lay out the Chain Blocks in 2 rows of 2 blocks. Sew rows together to complete the center of the quilt.

Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and back. Bind with your favorite Riley Blake fabric from the Floribella Collection. Have fun with your colors and enjoy the journey of making your quilt.
