This Quilt was made using a fat eighth of each of the 42 prints and 15 plaids. You will need 2 1/4 yard of fabric for stars (Item #9880-36)

## **Cutting Instructions:**

## **CENTER SQUARES**

**A.** Cut 80 squares (6 1/2" x 6 1/2") of assorted prints and plaids **SASHING** 

**B.** Cut 142 rectangles (3 1/2" x 6 1/2") of assorted prints and plaids **STARS** 


C. Cut 63 squares (3 1/2" x 3 1/2") of star fabrics.

D. Cut 568 squares (2" x 2") for star points.

## Piecing Instructions:

Using each of the 142 sashing pieces (B), sew a star point (D) to one corner as illustrated. Trim off excess and repeat to 3 remaining corners. Press.






Sashing pieces after you have added all four corners. The star points are cut generous so that when you join the quilt together, the star will float.

Following diagram, layout center squares, star centers and sashing pieces. Begin joining these pieces into rows.

Row 1



Row 2

Continue making rows as illustrated above. You need 10 of Row 1 and 9 of Row 2. Layout the rows using the picture of the quilt and join them together.

This is a great easy quilt to piece. It does take some time to sew all those squares on the sashing pieces, however it is well worth it in the end. Choose any of moda fabric collections to make other interesting combinations. Option: Sew 5 blocks across and 6 blocks down for an adorable baby quilt.
