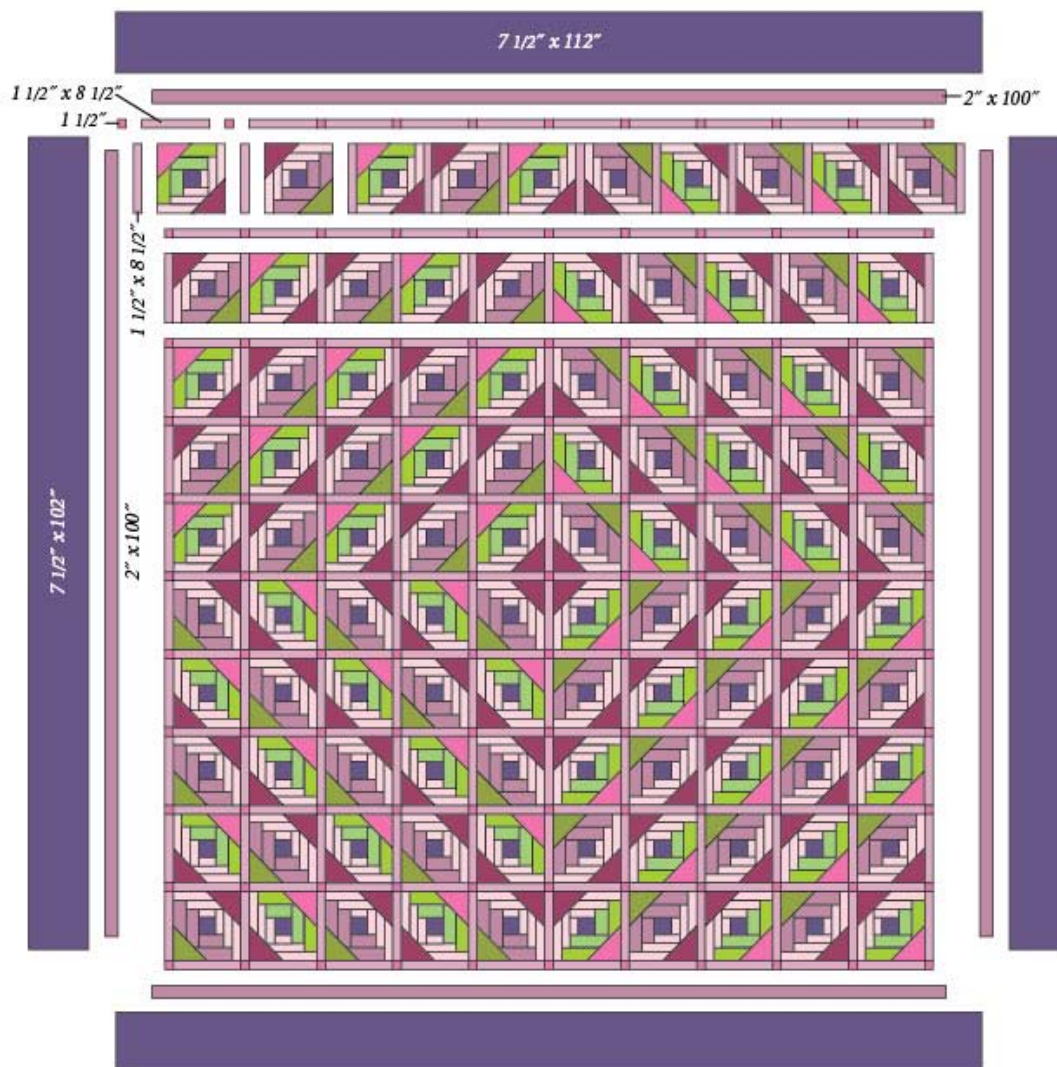


# Cactus Flower Web Bonus: King Size

**Finished Quilt Size**  
108 1/2" x 108 1/2"

**Number of Blocks & Finished Size**  
100 Log Cabin Variation Blocks  
8" x 8"

### Planning

Like a blooming garden, this quilt brings beauty and pleasure into any room. While it looks complicated, it is actually quite simple. Made of only one block design in 2 colorways, it is easy to piece, and fast, too!

### Fabric Requirements\*

Light pink mottle (blocks)	4 yds.
Purple/green swirl (blocks, outer border, binding)	4 yds.
#1 lime print (blocks)	7/8 yd.
#2 lime print (blocks)	1 1/2 yds.
Dark pink/green mottle (blocks, inner border)	2 1/2 yds.
Purple/multicolor print (blocks)	1 3/4 yds.
Pink mottle (blocks, sashing posts)	1 1/4 yds.
Pink/green print (blocks)	1 yd.
Lavender mottle (sashing)	2 1/2 yds.
Backing (piece lengthwise)	9 7/8 yds.
Batting size	King

\*All fabrics are batiks.

### Cutting Instructions

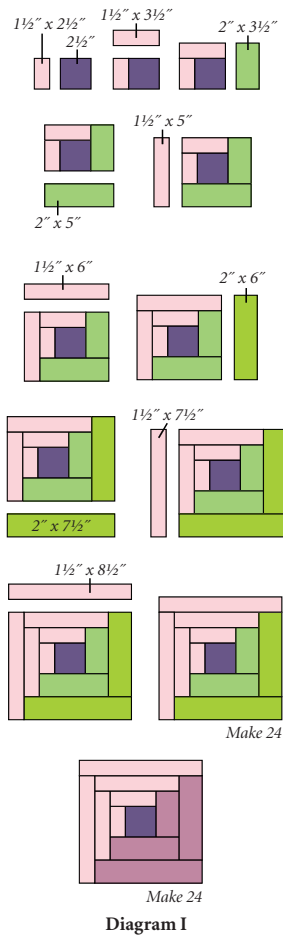
Light pink mottle	100 rectangles 1 1/2" x 2 1/2"
	100 strips 1 1/2" x 3 1/2"
	100 strips 1 1/2" x 5"
	100 strips 1 1/2" x 6"
	100 strips 1 1/2" x 7 1/2"
	100 strips 1 1/2" x 8 1/2"
Purple/green swirl	*2 strips 7 1/2" x 102", cut on lengthwise grain
	*2 strips 7 1/2" x 112", cut on lengthwise grain
100 squares 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"	
#1 lime print	50 rectangles 2" x 3 1/2"
	50 strips 2" x 5"
#2 lime print	50 strips 2" x 6"
	50 strips 2" x 7 1/2"

### Assembly Diagram

Dark pink/green mottle	*4 strips 2" x 100", pieced from 10 WOF strips
	50 rectangles 2" x 3 1/2"
	50 strips 2" x 5"
	50 strips 2" x 6"
	50 strips 2" x 7 1/2"
Purple/multicolor print	100 squares 4 1/2" x 4 1/2"
Pink mottle	50 squares 4 1/2" x 4 1/2"
	121 squares 1 1/2" x 1 1/2"
Pink/green print	50 squares 4 1/2" x 4 1/2"
Lavender mottle	220 strips 1 1/2" x 8 1/2"

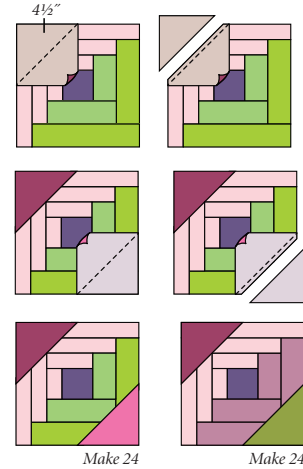
### Piecing the Blocks

1 Referring to **Diagram I**, sew light pink mottle  $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 2\frac{1}{2}''$  rectangle to purple/green swirl  $2\frac{1}{2}''$  square. Working clockwise, add strips as shown to make log cabin square. Make in colors and quantities shown.

2 Draw diagonal line on wrong side of purple/multicolor  $4\frac{1}{2}''$  square. Referring to **Diagram II**, place marked square on pink/lime log cabin square, right sides together, aligning raw edges.

Stitch on drawn line; trim away and discard excess fabric. Press open. Repeat on opposite corner using pink mottle  $4\frac{1}{2}''$  square to make Log Cabin Variation Block. Make in fabrics and quantities shown.

### Quilt Top Assembly

**Note:** Refer to **Assembly Diagram** on page 1 for following steps.

- 3 Sew 11 sashing rows using 11 pink mottle  $1\frac{1}{2}''$  squares and 10 lavender strips each. Watching placement and orientation carefully, stitch 10 block rows using 11 lavender strips and 10 blocks each. Sew rows together, alternating.
- 4 Sew dark pink/green  $100''$  strips to sides; trim even with top/bottom. Stitch remaining dark pink/green strips to top/bottom; trim even with sides. Sew purple/green swirl  $100''$  strips to sides; trim even. Stitch remaining purple/green strips to top/bottom; trim even.

### Quilting and Finishing

- 5 Layer, baste, and quilt. Bind with purple/green swirl.
