

# Mini Quilt Trio

A free pattern from 100 Billion Stars



*These easy, colorful projects are perfect for your scrap stash. Mix and match colors and prints with abandon. Make some to have on hand for gifts. Or create seasonal versions. A little time and a lot of fun are all you need. A basic understanding of piecing and quilting is required.*

## Flower Patch – A Nine Patch Mini

Make four pieced squares using four pieces of template A per square. Trim to 4". (Diagram 1)

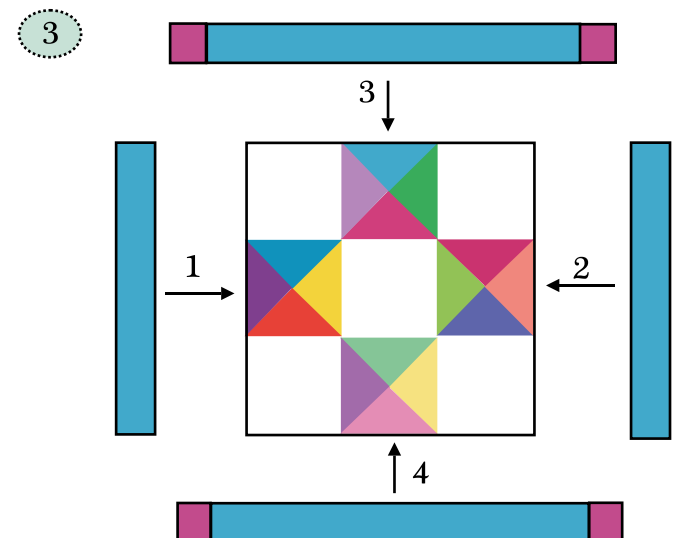
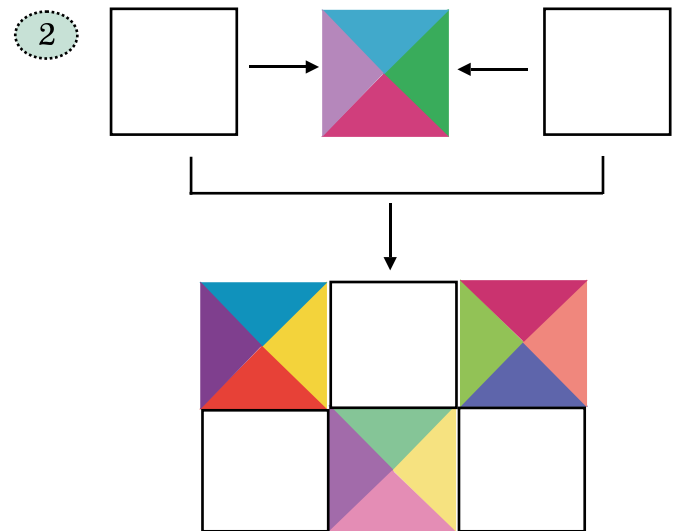
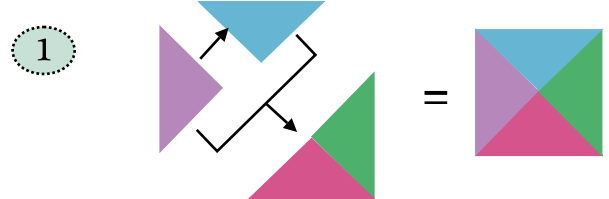
Sew blocks together as shown at right. Sew rows together. (Diagram 2)

Cut border strips to size. Sew strips to sides as shown in diagram. Sew 2" corner squares to each end of top and bottom border strips. Sew to block. (Diagram 3)

Layer backing, batting and pieced top. Quilt as desired.

Attach binding to front side. Turn to back. Press and sew in place.

Seam allowances are 1/4" unless noted otherwise.



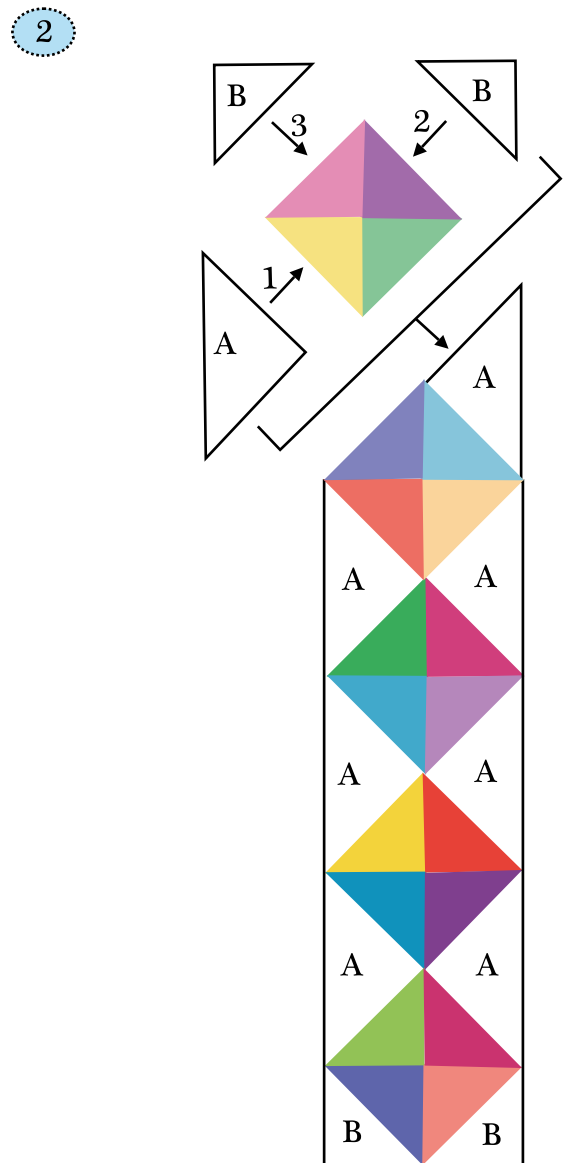
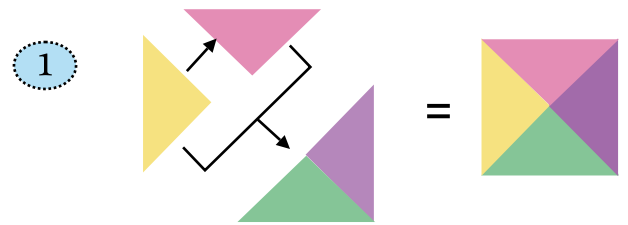
## Skinny Mini – A Square On Point Row

Make five pieced squares using four pieces of template A per square. Trim to 3". (Diagram 1)

Assemble squares and triangles in rows as shown. (Diagram 2)

Layer backing, batting and pieced top. Quilt, if desired. Using Anchor pearl cotton thread, attach buttons to points where squares meet.

Attach binding to front side. Turn to back. Press and sew in place.



Seam allowances are 1/4" unless noted otherwise.





## Out the Window – A Sashed Four Patch Mini

Make four pieced squares using four pieces of template A per square. Trim to 4". (Diagram 1)

Sew 4" x 1 1/2" strip to one side of block. Sew 5" x 1 1/2" strip to adjacent side of block. Repeat for each block. (Diagram 2)

Sew 5 1/4" x 1 1/2" strip to block. Sew other side of this strip to second block. Repeat for remaining two blocks. (Diagram 3)

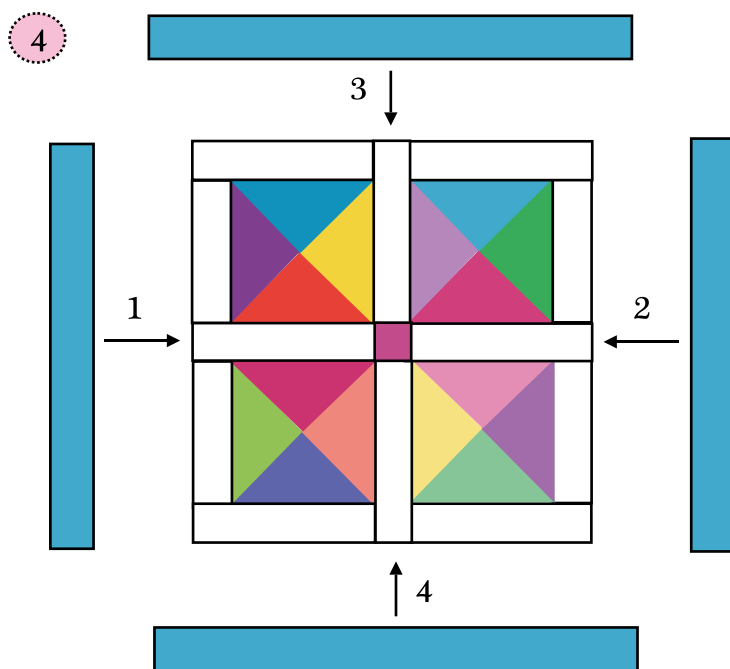
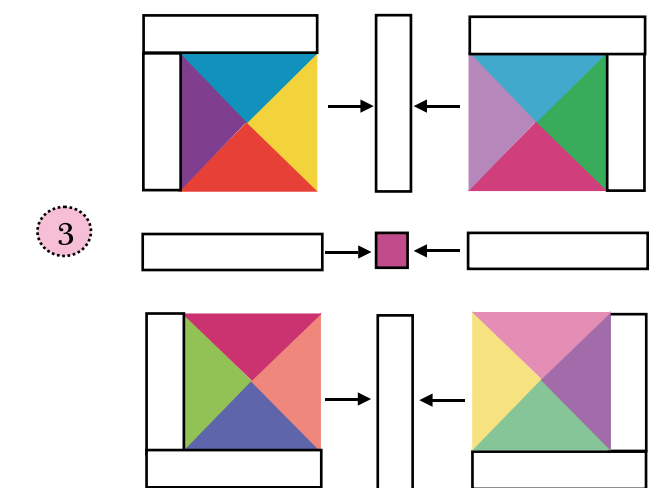
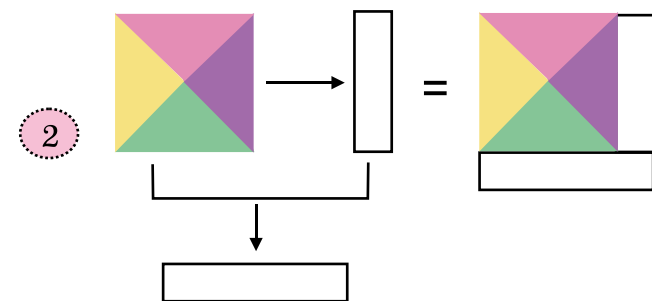
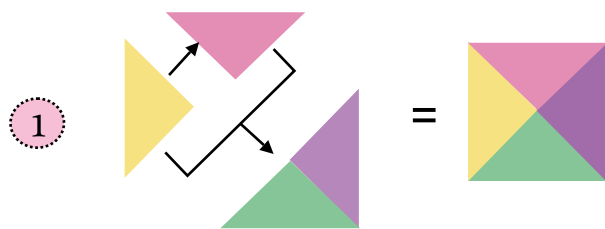
Sew center square to remaining 5 1/4" x 1 1/2" strips. Sew rows together. (Diagram 3)

Sew border strips to sides. Sew border strips to top and bottom. (Diagram 4)

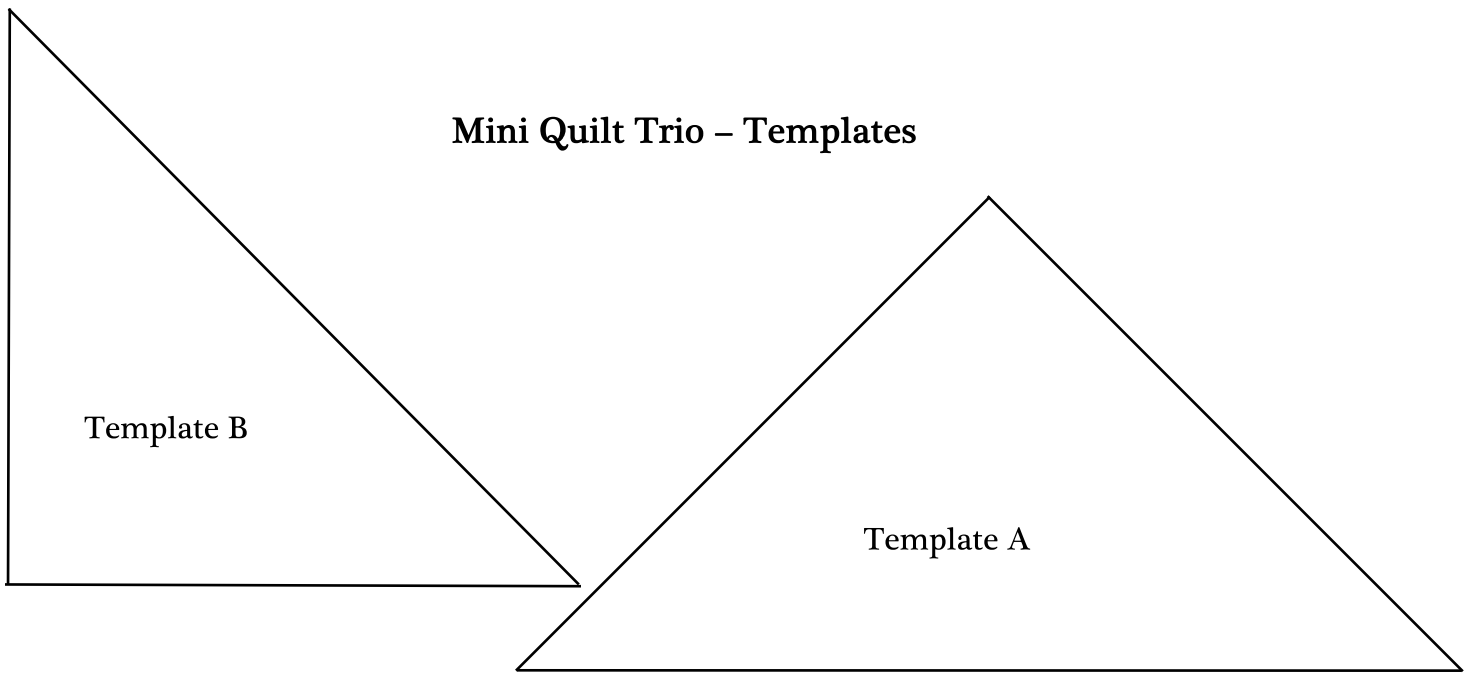
Layer backing, batting and pieced top. Quilt as desired.

Attach binding to front side. Turn to back. Press and sew in place.

Seam allowances are 1/4" unless noted otherwise.



## Mini Quilt Trio – Templates



### Flower Patch

- Template A..... 16 pieces from scraps
- 4" squares..... 5 pieces of white solid
- Border Strips..... 2" Width of Fabric strip
- 2" corner squares..... 4 pieces of white solid
- Binding..... Approximately 70"
- Backing..... Approximately 16" square

### Skinny Mini

- Template A..... 20 pieces from scraps
- Template A..... 8 pieces of white solid
- Template B..... 4 pieces of white solid
- Binding..... Approximately 56"
- Backing..... Approximately 8" x 24"
- Buttons..... 9 of varying colors and sizes

### Out the Window

- Template A..... 16 pieces from scraps
- 1 ½" Center Square.. 1 fussy cut scrap
- Sashing..... 4 - 1 ½" x 4" strips from white solid  
4 - 1 ½" x 5" strips from white solid  
4 - 1 ½" x 5 ¼" strips from white solid
- Border Strips..... 1 ½" x Width of Fabric (total length approx. 48")
- Binding..... Approximately 60"
- Backing..... Approximately 16" square
