

Project: Precut Cutting Chart

PRECUT 2½"-WIDE STRIPS

Widely known as a Jelly Roll, packages of 2½"-wide strips are oh-so-useful!

(Numbers here are based on a package of strips containing forty 42" strips.)

*Based on standard bed sizes with a 14" drop.

*Number of twin-size quilts you can bind.

Number of 2½" squares you can cut.

*Number of queen-size quilts you can bind.

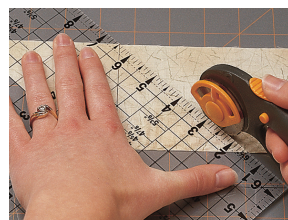
Number of 45° diamonds you can cut (cut one strip end at a 45° angle, then cut diamonds 2½" wide).

*Number of king-size quilts you can bind.

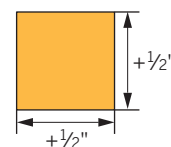

Number of equilateral triangles you can cut (triangles will finish 1¾" tall).



HOW MANY CAN I GET?: SQUARES

Use this chart to determine the number of squares that can be cut from various precuts. Yardage figures include ¼" seam allowances. The figures on this chart are mathematically accurate. You may want to purchase extra fabric to allow for errors.
