

Cutting and Preparation

From Fabric A, cut: One 3-1/2" x 8-1/2" One 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" piece

From Fabric B, cut: One 8-1/2" x 11" piece One 5-1/2" square One 3-1/2" x 5-1/2" piece One 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" piece

From Fabric C, cut: Six 2" x WOF strips

From Fabric D, cut: One 7-1/2" x 9" piece One 4" x 8-1/2"

From Fabric E, cut: One 8-1/2" x 10-1/2" piece One 3" x 12-1/2" piece One 2" x 8-1/2" piece One 1-1/2" x 9" piece One 2-1/2" square

From Fabric F, cut: One 5-1/2" x 14-1/2" piece

From Fabric G, cut: One 8-1/2" x 9-1/2" piece One 2-1/2" x 10-1/2" piece

From Fabric H, cut: One 5-1/2" x 6-1/2" piece One 2-1/2" x10-1/2" piece

From Fabric I, cut: One 6-1/2" x 7-1/2" piece One 5" x 6" piece Two 4-1/2" x 10-1/2" pieces One 3" x 10" piece One 2-1/2" x 5-1/2' piece

From Fabric J, cut: One 10-1/2" x 11-1/2" piece One 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" piece One 3-1/2" x 7-1/2" piece

From Fabric K, cut: One 8-1/2" x 9-1/2" piece One 7-1/2" x 12-1/2" piece One 3-1/2" x 7-1/2" piece One 2-1/2" square

From Fabric L, cut: One 7-1/2" x 11-1/2" piece One 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" piece

From Fabric N, cut: One $6-1/2'' \times 14-1/2$ piece One $6-1/2'' \times 10-1/2''$ piece One $2-1/2'' \times 21-1/2''$ piece One $3-1/2'' \times 5-1/2''$ piece Reserve remainder for applique

From Fabric O, cut: One 4-1/2" x 19-1/2" piece One 5-1/2" x 10-1/2" piece One 4-1/2" x 10-1/2" piece One 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" piece One 3-1/2" x 4-1/2" piece

From Fabric P, cut: One 7-1/2" x 8-1/2" piece One 3-1/2" x 12-1/2" piece One 2-1/2" square

From Fabric S, cut: One 5-1/2" x 16-1/2" piece One 4-1/2" x 6-1/2" piece

From Fabric T, cut: One 7-1/2" x 10-1/2" piece One 4-1/2" x 9-1/2" piece One 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" piece

From Fabric V, cut: Two 4-1/2" x 5-1/2" pieces

From Fabric W, cut: One 3" x 7-1/2" piece One 3" x 5-1/2" piece From Fabric X, cut: One 9-1/2" x 10-1/2" piece

From Fabric Y, cut: One 5-1/2" x 10-1/2" piece One 4" x 6-1/2" piece One 2" x 5-1/2" piece

From Fabric Z, cut: One 5-1/2" x 7-1/2" piece

From Fabric AA, cut: One 7-1/2" x 16-1/2" piece

From Fabric BB, cut: One $6-1/2'' \times 11-1/2''$ piece One $4'' \times 9-1/2''$ piece

From Fabric CC, cut: One 10-1/2″ x 11-1/2" piece

From Fabric DD, cut: One 8-1/2" x 12-1/2" piece One 4-1/2" square One 3" x 8-1/2" piece

From Fabric EE, cut: One 3-1/2" x 10-1/2" piece

From Fabric FF, cut: One 5" x 8-1/2" piece One 2-1/2" x 14" piece One 2-1/2" x 3" piece

From Fabric GG, cut: One 5-1/2" x 8-1/2" piece One 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" piece

From Fabric HH, cut: One 5-1/2" x 9" piece One 3-1/2" x 9" piece One 2-1/2" x 11-1/2" piece One 1-1/2" x 4" piece

From Fabric II, cut: One 7-1/2" x 11-1/2" piece From Fabric JJ, cut: One 5-1/2" x 6-1/2" piece One 3-1/2" x 8-1/2" piece One 2-1/2" x 7-1/2" piece

From Fabric KK, cut: Six 2-1/4" x WOF strips for binding Reserve remainder for applique


Use Fabrics M, N, O, Q, R, U, KK, LL, MM, and NN for applique.

Preparation


Trace templates in reverse onto the paper side of fusible web to create mirror images, labeling as indicated. Note that some templates are larger than the page and will need to be joined along the longer dotted lines (marked on the templates). Also, some templates have a dotted outline--this is just to differentiate templates where layering occurs on the template pages. Cut out each shape 1/4" past the line. Fuse the shapes to the indicated fabric and cut out on the lines.

Piecing the Background


1. Section 1: Make unit 1a by sewing a 5-1/2" x 3" W piece to a 5-1/2" x 2"Y piece. Sew a 9-1/2" x 4-1/2"T piece to the right side. Make unit 1b by sewing a 10-1/2" x 5-1/2"Y piece to a 4-1/2" x 5-1/2"V piece. Make unit 1c by sewing a 6-1/2" x 4" Y piece to a 6-1/2" x 11-1/2" BB piece; sew an 8-1/2" x 12-1/2" DD piece to an 8-1/2" x 3" DD piece. Join the BB/Y unit to the DD/DD unit. Make unit 1d by sewing a 7-1/2" x 3"W piece, a 7-1/2" x 5-1/2" Z piece and a 7-1/2" x 16-1/2" AA piece together. Join units 1a-1c, and then add unit 1d to the left side. Section 1 should measure 21-1/2" x 24".




2. Section 2: Make unit 2a by sewing an 8-1/2" x 4-1/2"T piece to a 6-1/2" x 4-1/2" S piece. Make unit 2b by sewing a 4-1/2" x 5-1/2"V piece to a 4-1/2" DD square. Join the V/DD unit to a 10-1/2" x 9-1/2" X piece. Make unit 2c by sewing a 2-1/2" P square to a 12-1/2" x 2-1/2" L piece. Sew the P/L unit to a 14-1/2" x 6-1/2" N piece. Join units 2a-2c. Section 2 should measure 14-1/2" x 21-1/2".




3. Section 3: To make unit 3a, sew a 10-1/2" x 7-1/2"T piece to a 10-1/2" x 6-1/2" N piece. To make unit 3b, sew a 5-1/2" x 3-1/2" N piece to a 5-1/2" x 3-1/2" B piece. Join units 3a and 3b, and then sew the 5-1/2" x 16-1/2" S piece to the left side. Section 3 should measure 15-1/2" x 16-1/2".




4. Section 4: To make unit 4a, sew a 4" x 9-1/2" BB piece to a 4" x 1-1/2" HH piece. Sew to the left side of an 11-1/2" x 10-1/2" CC piece. Sew a 4-1/2" x 10-1/2" I piece to the right side. To make unit 4b, sew an 8-1/2" x 5" FF piece to a 6" x 5" I piece. Sew a 3" x 2-1/2" FF piece to an 11-1/2" x 2-1/2" HH piece. Sew a 14" x 2-1/2" FF piece to the top. Join the FF/I unit to the FF/HH/FF unit. Sew a 5-1/2" x 9" HH piece to the left side. To make unit 4c, sew a 10-1/2" x 3-1/2" EE piece to a 9" x 3-1/2" HH piece. To make unit 4d, sew a 3" x 10" I piece to a 3" x 12-1/2" E piece. Join units 4a-4c and then sew unit 4d to the right side. Section 4 should measure 21-1/2" x 22".




5. Section 5: To make unit 5a, sew a 6-1/2" x 7-1/2" I piece to an 8-1/2" x 7-1/2" P piece. To make unit 5b, sew a 2-1/2" x 5-1/2" I piece to a 2-1/2" E square, and then sew to the left side of a 12-1/2" x 7-1/2" K piece. Join unit 5a to 5b. Section 5 should measure 14-1/2" square.




6. Section 6: To make unit 6a, sew a 2-1/2" K square to a 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" B piece. Sew to the left side of a 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" A piece, and sew a 5-1/2" B square to the top, and then add a 11-1/2" x 7-1/2" L piece To make unit 6b, sew a 9-1/2" x 8-1/2" K piece to a 3-1/2" x 8-1/2" A piece. To make unit 6c, sew a 3-1/2" x 12-1/2" P piece to a 3-1/2" x 7-1/2" K piece. Join unit 6a to 6b and then add 6c to the left side. Section 6 should measure 15-1/2" x 19-1/2".




7. Section 7: To make unit 7a, sew together a 2" x 8-1/2" E piece, an 11" x 8-1/2" B piece, and a 9-1/2" x 8-1/2" G piece. Add a 21-1/2" x 2-1/2" N piece to the top. Sew an 8-1/2" x 10-1/2" E piece to unit 7a. Section 7 should measure 29-1/2" x 10-1/2".



8. Section 8: To make unit 8a, sew an $8-1/2" \ge 5-1/2"$ GG piece to an $8-1/2" \ge 3-1/2"$ JJ piece. To make unit 8b, sew a 9" $\ge 1-1/2"$ E piece to a 9" $\ge 7-1/2"$ D piece. Add a 4" $\ge 8-1/2"$ D piece to the left side. To make unit 8c, sew a $6-1/2" \ge 5-1/2"$ JJ piece to a $14-1/2" \ge 5-1/2"$ F piece. To make unit 8d, sew a $7-1/2" \ge 1-1/2"$ II piece to a $7-1/2" \ge 2-1/2"$ JJ piece. To make unit 8e, sew an $8-1/2" \ge 4-1/2"$ GG piece to a $19-1/2" \ge 4-1/2"$ O piece. Join unit 8a to 8b; add 8c to the bottom and then 8d to the left. Sew 8e to the top. Section 8 should measure $27-1/2" \ge 1-1/2"$



9. Section 9: To make unit 9a, sew a $3-1/2" \times 4-1/2"$ O piece to a $3-1/2" \times 7-1/2"$ J piece. To make unit 9b, sew a $10-1/2" \times 2-1/2"$ G piece to a $10-1/2" \times 4-1/2"$ l piece. Sew a $10-1/2" \times 5-1/2"$ O piece to the bottom. To make unit 9c, sew an $8-1/2" \times 2-1/2"$ O piece to an $8-1/2" \times 4-1/2"$ J piece. Sew a $5-1/2" \times 6-1/2"$ H piece to the left side. To make unit 9d, sew a $10-1/2" \times 4-1/2"$ O piece to a $10-1/2" \times 11-1/2"$ J piece and a $10-1/2" \times 2-1/2"$ H piece to the bottom. Join unit 9a to 9b. Add unit 9c to the bottom and unit 9d to the left side. Section 9 should measure $23-1/2" \times 17-1/2"$.



10. To assemble the pieced background, refer to the Quilt Layout Diagram as you work. Sew Section 1 to the top of Section 4. Sew Section 2 to the top of Section 5. Sew Section 3 to the top of Section 6. Join Sections 2/5 to Sections 3/6 and then sew Section 7 to the bottom. Sew Section 1/4 to the left side. Sew Section 8 to the left of Section 9 and then add to the bottom to complete the pieced background center. It should measure 50-1/2" x 62-1/2".

11. Sew the six 2" x WOF C strips short end together. Cut two 62-1/2" lengths and two 53-1/2" lengths. Sew the longer strips to the sides of the quilt and the shorter strips to the top and bottom.

Add the Applique

1. Referring to the Placement Diagram on page 8, position the flower and leaf shapes on the pieced background and fuse in place, following manfacturer's directions.

2. If desired, use a straight stitch or decorative stitch to applique pieces in place.

Finish the Quilt

1. Layer the quilt back right side down, batting, and quilt top right side up. Baste layers together and quilt as desired. Trim backing and batting to edge of quilt top.

2. Use the six 2-1/4" x 42" Fabric KK strips to bind the quilt.
