## Granny Square Coasters

Finished Size: $4^{3} / 4^{\prime \prime}$ square


## Materials (makes 4):

$52 \times 1^{11 / 2 "}$ coloured squares (13 per coaster)
Background, Backing \& Binding: Long Quarter Metre
$4 \times 43 / 4$ " squares of Wadding
505 Basting Spray
Co-ordinating Thread

## Cut Out

From Background Fabric cut:
Four $11 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 22^{\prime \prime}$ strips (Binding)
Four $43 / 4$ " squares (Backing)
Twenty Four $1^{3 /} / 4^{\prime \prime}$ squares cut in half diagonally (Background)

## Make It

Use size 80/12 standard needle for piecing
Use scant $1 / 4$ " seam allowance

## Make the Front (4)

1. Layout all the squares and setting triangles as shown (Fig 1).

2. Sew the pieces right sides together in diagonal rows (Figs $2 \& 3$ ). Do not attach the corner triangles at this stage.

3. Press the seams of each row in alternating directions before joining the rows right sides together (Fig 4). Nest/butt the intersecting seams before pinning and sewing.

4. Press the seams of the joining rows open.
5. Sew a triangle right sides together to each corner (these will be bigger than you need so just centre them). Press seams open.
6. Trim the coaster to $43 / 4$ " square (Fig 5 ).

7. Spray baste the front, wadding and backing fabrics together and quilt as desired.
8. Attach binding using Single Fold Binding method (tutorial available here: https://justjude-designs.com/techniques/bindings-finishes//).
